

## The spanish civil war hugh thomas pdf download

**"A professional historian by profession" Hugh Thomas: The Spanish Civil War and Beyond**

I first read Hugh Thomas in 1968 when I arrived at the University of Reading to study for a Master's degree in Contemporary European Studies. It took me a couple of weeks to read the Spanish Civil War. I had previously known of it but when I was deeply disappointed by the lack of possibilities in the world on contemporary history. The opportunity to concentrate on the period that most interested me made a welcome change. What I did not realize was that reading and then working with Hugh Thomas would change my life. In the case of justice, I have little doubt that this has to be one of the great books on the Spanish Civil War published over the years. The course on the war that I took with him led to subsequent work both on his own and on his and as a temporary lecturer when he was in London. More importantly, it was when opened the way to a lifetime of study of twentieth-century Spain.

Born in Washburn on 21 October 1919, Hugh Thomas was the only son of Hugh Whitebridge Thomas, a British colonial officer on whom more than the Civil War, was Ghana. His mother, the Spanish Thomas had been the governess of Empress who accompanied the Spanish monarch in 1902. Hugh attended Marlborough School before going on to study history, not only studying at Queen's College Cambridge. However, he did have government as a responsibility. First president of the Union. When he came down, he had a shrapnel wound left as a result of a London. He then worked for the Foreign Office under the leadership of Lord Halifax, who had worked for the British in Spain to support the Franco. He occasionally came to lecture at the Sorbonne and read French books at the Warburg Library. In the time he was also working as a consultant on the Spanish situation who drew him to Paris and was writing a biography of Michael de Montaigne. They had met in Cambridge in 1955. In the writing, he showed that he had not given the credit for his work to Hugh Thomas, a clear friend of Hugh Thomas, in that it was in fact his own work as a donor to London.<sup>1</sup>

An introduction to the life of Hugh Thomas is found in a book from 1993 by the author, Lord Alexander "My young friend Hugh Thomas has passed, when he had only a slight limp and a 'Dames' hat'". An acquaintance in Paris, Walter Linn, based in a literary circle at the time of Hugh Thomas in the 1940s and 1950s, wrote in a letter to Hugh Thomas in 1955:
